



# Crisis Care Facility (CCF) By-law

Ajax Council will be considering a By-law to license Crisis Care Facilities in Ajax on Monday, December 8.

## What is the purpose of the Crisis Care Facility By-law?

The purpose of the Crisis Care Facility (C.C.F.) by-law is to regulate the day-to-day operation of crisis care facilities in the Town of Ajax.

## What is a Crisis Care Facility?

A C.C.F. is a building or part thereof operated, that provides temporary accommodation and associated support services to persons requiring immediate emergency shelter and/or related care.

## Who does this by-law affect?

This by-law affects service providers or agencies of temporary emergency accommodation and support services to those experiencing homelessness, domestic violence, or other crises. Operators include public authorities, non-profit organizations, charitable agencies and other entities.

## **Who will benefit from the C.C.F. By-law?**

The licensing for C.C.F.s will create a system that protects facility users and residents, as well as the residents and businesses in the surrounding community.

## **What does this by-law entail for the operators of C.C.F.s?**

The by-law outlines that a valid C.C.F. licence is required to operate, advertise, broker, and permit a C.C.F. in the Town of Ajax. It requires the licensee to comply with the regulations set out in the By-law, obtaining a separate licence for each property from which the C.C.F. is operated, regardless of licensing for another C.C.F. under the same service provider.

## **How to receive licensing for a C.C.F. under the new By-law?**

Applications for licensing and renewals of licences shall be made through the Manager of By-law Services. The Town will be working closely with operators for the first few months after enactment of the by-law to accommodate for the application period and ensure compliance with the requirements.

## **What are the requirements of the licence application?**

The application requires the operators of the C.C.F. to ensure their facility has or will have minimal to no impact on the surrounding area. This requires compliance with associated by-laws regarding zoning, smoking and vaping, public nuisance and safety, and fire safety. It also requires evidence of insurance, adequate parking, appropriate numbers of staff, 24-hour security, as well as a plan maintenance of the lot and impact on surrounding area.

## **Are there any exceptions to the by-law?**

All facilities must obtain a licence. However, exceptions to some of the requirements to obtain a licence may be made at the discretion of Town senior staff as outlined in the by-law.

## **I am an operator of a C.C.F. What happens now?**

The Town will be in contact with all operators of a C.C.F. following the enactment of the by-law by Council to provide forms and next steps. Council has permitted a grace period to ensure all operators have the appropriate time to prepare the required documentation to apply for a licence.

## **Is there a limit to how many licences/establishments one provider may hold?**

There is no limit to the number of licences a provider may hold. One licence is required per each physical location of a C.C.F.

## **What happens if a facility cannot meet the requirements of the C.C.F. By-law?**

A C.C.F. must meet the requirements outlined in the by-law to receive a licence. No C.C.F. is permitted to operate without a licence in the Town of Ajax.

## **What happens if a facility obtains a licence, but does not comply with the terms of the by-law?**

Failure to comply to the requirements of the licence according to the by-law may result in formal enforcement action from By-law Services, including but not limited to formal notices, fines or the revocation of a licence.

## **When will the C.C.F. By-law be put into place?**

If Council approves the By-law on December 8, it will come into effect immediately. However, the Town will work with operators over the coming months with an estimated time for compliance in Spring 2026.
